1. This advertisement follows the General Procurement Notice which appeared in the PPRA Portal and Tanzania Procurement Journal Issue No. 1821-6021 Vol. VII-No. 33 of 19th August, 2014.
2. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has set aside funds for the operation of the Ministry of Community Development, Gender and Children during the financial year 2014/2015. It is intended that part of the proceeds of these funds will be used to cover eligible payment under the contract for the **Proposed Construction of Car parking, landscaping at MCDGC Head Office Dar es Salaam and rehabilitation of various buildings for Msaginya and Mto wa Mbu Folk Development Colleges.**
3. The Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Community Development, Gender and Children now invites sealed Tenders from eligible contractors registered with Contractors Registration Board (CRB) in **Classes shown** for carrying out the following works:
